

The Queen's Jubilee Celebrations

Timing of Events the 2nd June

Below is a general outline of our plan as part of the wider Appledore Jubilee celebrations, please note times might be a little flexible.

Recreation ground set-up:	9am – 11am
A light-hearted inclusive celebratory service with popular hymns. Ending with “God Save the Queen” to be held in a marquee on the Recreation Ground:	11am - 11:45am
Appledore Local Historic Society exhibition in the village hall:	12pm – 4:30pm
Platinum Jubilee tree planting ceremony, on the Recreation ground:	12pm – 12:15pm
Village Hall opens for “Royally Celebrating the Coronation” showing a continuous reel of The Coronation, with Pimm’s and Coronation Sandwiches:	12pm – 2:30pm
Village Hall Children 12 years or younger welcomed. Dressed as a Prince or Princess (tiaras expected!!) to receive prizes. Organised activities include create a posy fit for the Queen, regal colouring pictures and royal Icing – decorate a royal biscuit:	12pm - 2:30pm
Romney Marsh Morris Side, a display of traditional dance, Rec’ ground:	2pm – 3pm
Village Hall serving cream teas:	2:30pm – 4:30pm
Cinque Lindy Hoppers music and dance troupe, the Recreation Ground:	3pm – 4:30pm
Heart and Harper local duet on the Recreation Ground:	5pm – 6:30pm
The Rockitmen on the Recreation Ground:	7pm – 9:15pm
Lighting of the beacon (timing of this is national per HRH Pageant Master):	9:35pm
Milly Piper, piping the specially written piece “ <i>Diu Regnare</i> ”:	9:20pm – 9:40pm

Please note the village will hold the “street party” on the recreation ground from 12-noon, including stalls from The Black Lion Pub, Nightingales Farm Shop, Pimm’s Waggon, The Grapevine, Ice-cream Van, Gusbourne Wines, The Appledore Garden Society, Beverly’s Ceramics, A Royal Smashing Time, and packed picnic lunches for kids.
