4 Request for Funding from Appledore Recreation Ground

A request has been received from the Recreation Ground Committee for an 'in principle' agreement for funds whilst they more accurately cost the initial stages of their future plans for the recreation ground and pavilion. £50,000 for pavilion building and roof with a renewal energy sourced heating and hot water and £10,000 for an outdoor adult fitness gym.

Heathside Proposed New Play Area

A letter was hand delivered to all the households on Heathside asking for resident's thoughts and comments about installing a small play area on the grass area which includes the shelter. Most households responded. The overwhelming comment was that it was not a suitable location and that increasing the current provision on the recreation ground was preferable. As a result, the parish council has contacted Ashford Borough Council to see whether this would be allowed. We await their advice.

The council is writing to Ashford Borough Council to highlight the issue and to ascertain if the borough council will provide additional parking in some form.
